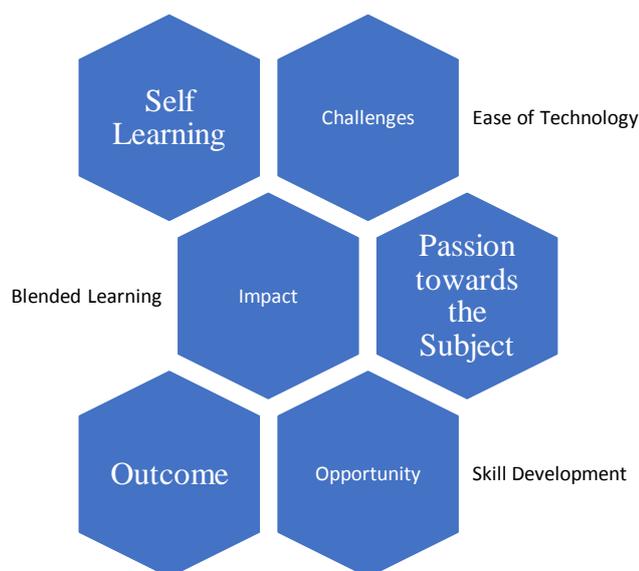
Introduction:
